Refunds

If you feel uncomfortable having your child in a camp setting, you may request a refund according to the following schedule:

- Up to and including 15 days prior to the start of your camp week: Receive a full refund less any credit card fees.
- Between 8 and 14 days prior to the start of your camp week: Receive a 50% refund of camp fees. Credit card fees will not be refunded.
- 7 days or less before your camp week starts: No refunds unless you have a documented case of Covid-19 in your household.

Cancellations

If we are forced to cancel camp in the course of the summer, you have a choice:

- Elect to credit your fees toward next year's summer camp or Fall 2020 lessons
- Receive a refund
- Donate all or a portion of your fees to help us continue to care for the horses

Things to Bring With You to Camp

- **Plastic bin with top**, labeled clearly on body and top with the camper's name. The box should be large enough to store the items a camper will need during the day, such as a change of clothes, extra shoes, bathing suit, towel, etc.
- **Grooming kit**, which includes at least a firm brush, a soft brush, hoof pick, curry comb, and sweat scraper. **We are selling grooming kits for \$20.00** or you may bring your own. If your child arrives without a grooming kit, they will be use one of ours and you will be charged \$20.00. All items must be clearly labeled with the rider's name. You can use the grooming kit if you continue in the lesson program. The kit can be stored at the barn for the week.

More things to bring with you

- **Helmet**, clearly labeled with the rider's name. We have helmets available and will wipe/spray them down after each use, but the best solution is to have your own helmet and make sure it is labeled with your name. A Troxel helmet can be purchased for \$25-\$30. Do not buy a used helmet, since you cannot know for sure if it has been damaged. Bicycle helmets do not meet the safety standards required for horseback riding and are not permitted. The helmet can be stored in the child's bin during the week.
- **Lunch and snack every day**. Lunches that need refrigeration may be given to the counselor to place in the refrigerator. The group counselor will hand out the lunches. Children should be reminded not to share their food or drinks.
- **Full water bottle every day**, clearly labeled with their name. We will keep a supply of small disposable bottles with water on hand in case someone needs more water.
- **Sun screen and bug spray**
- **Attire:**
 - for horse activities, long pants or leggings and boots with a low heel
 - for the afternoon, shorts and a top
 - for water activities, a bathing suit and towel
